*Please note that the data provided covers a three-month period only and should not be interpreted as representative of long-term air quality conditions at this location. Air quality assessments and compliance with national objectives are based on annual average concentrations, as pollution levels can vary significantly throughout the year due to weather, traffic patterns, and seasonal factors.

The results have also not been bias-adjusted against long-term reference monitoring data, and no distance correction has been applied. As such, the data should be treated as indicative only, rather than a definitive measure of annual exposure or compliance with air quality standards.

No additional monitoring has been added to

- **Fellgate Avenue**
- **Durham Drive**

I did advise that we would be reviewing the network imminently, officers have been determining additional sites, with a view to install in May. All new locations will be identified in our Annual Status report which is completed in June and submitted to Defra for approval. Following approval, we can share with members of the public.

- I would advise that diffusion tubes are regularly reviewed
- I can confirm that the team will be **reviewing our diffusion tube monitoring network imminently, and we are looking to provide additional monitoring locations in the area, this will include Fellgate.**

Can I please ask when the Air Diffusion tubes were checked in the following locations and if possible could I have a copy of the past three readings from each.-

- DT8 - Holland Park drive (A19)
- DT9- Southlands (A19)

Could I also please ask if any additional Air Quality testing has been carried out in and around the following locations during the past 3 months:-

- Fellgate Avenue
- Durham Drive
